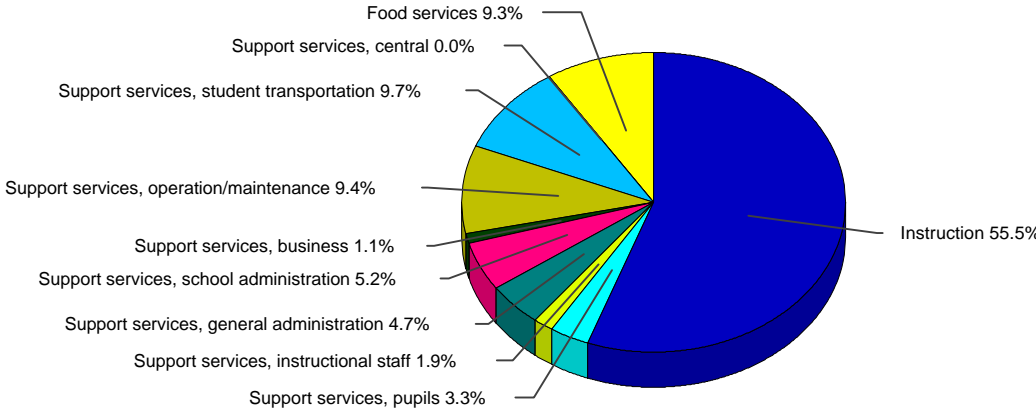
**FINANCIAL INFORMATION**
