Extremely exciting activities within the Lincoln County School system have transpired over the past 12 months. With a total commitment from all employees, we have seen our financial problems ease as we have removed ourselves from a deficit situation. This has occurred while the system moved progressively and in a positive manner. SAT-9 scores have risen and many new programs are being implemented through various grants to our county. The School-to-Work project is moving along at a rapid pace and new additions are either completed or are nearing completion which ultimately results in the merger of four elementary schools. The system is anxiously awaiting the future as we are working with the Steering Committee to develop a new ten-year CEFP with the entire focus on improving educational opportunities for all students in Lincoln County.

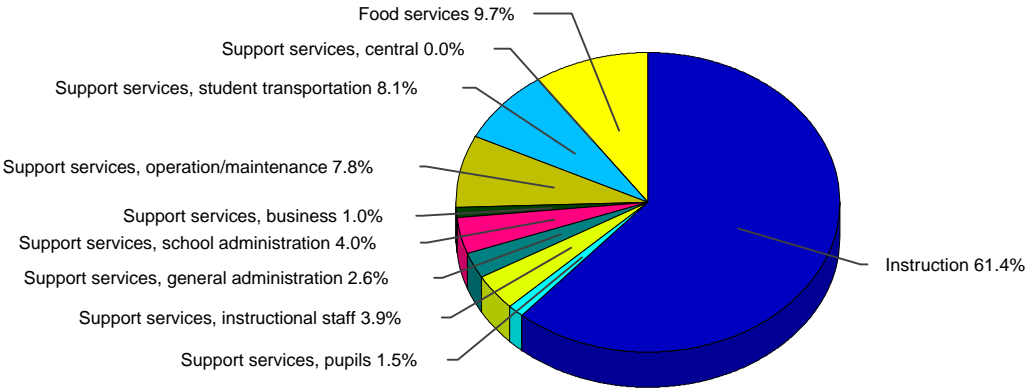
FINANCIAL INFORMATION
