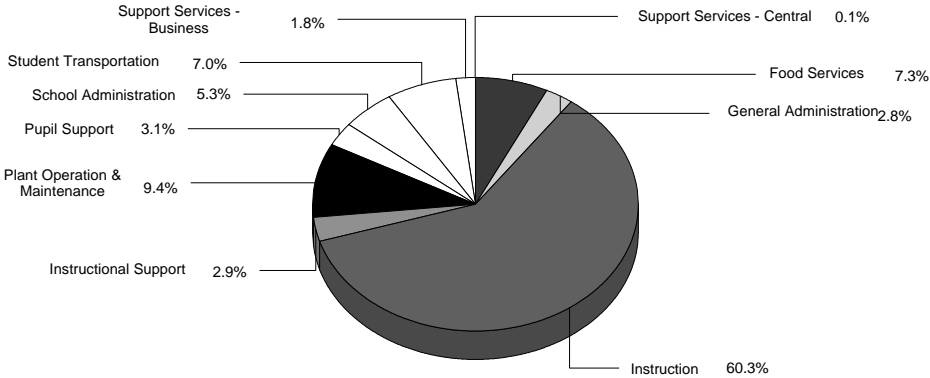
FINANCIAL INFORMATION
