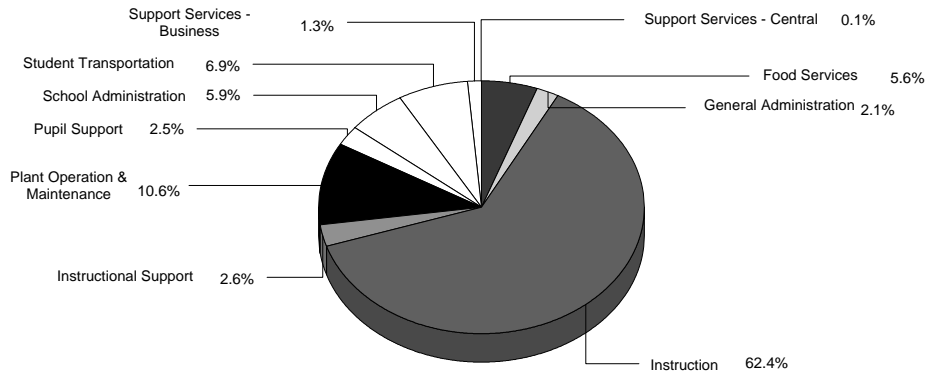
FINANCIAL INFORMATION
