## MESSAGE FROM THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT

Wetzel County Schools has a tradition of excellence for its students. Scoring in the upper quarter of state testing programs is evidence that our motto, "Learning for All," drives teachers to have high expectations for students. The four high schools serve their communities by providing a focal point for social interaction as well as for learning.

Families are important in Wetzel County. Several programs seek to encourage the partnership of parents with the school in providing excellent educational opportunities for all children. A Parent Center staffed with educators serves as a resource for parents who seek assistance with parenting or with educational problems.

Students excel in co-curricular activities, such as TSA and FFA, as is evidenced by their success in state and national contests. Extra-curricular programs allow students to develop team work skills as well as to hone their own athletic abilities through interscholastic competition.

Wetzel County Schools system has also benefitted from the federal class-size reduction program for the past two years. Three teachers have been hired during each of the past two years, resulting in an average reduction for the affected classrooms from an average class size of 23.4 students per teacher to an average class size of 17.3 students per teacher.

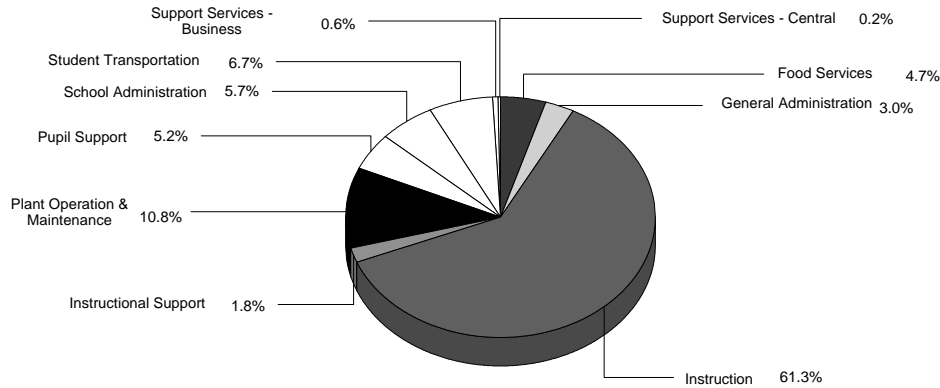
## FINANCIAL INFORMATION
