MESSAGE FROM THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT

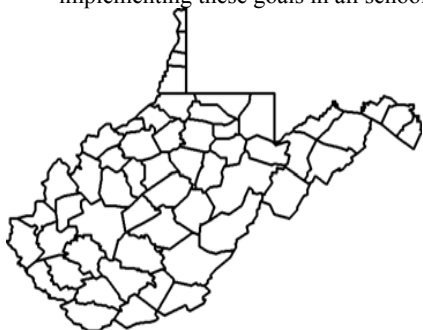

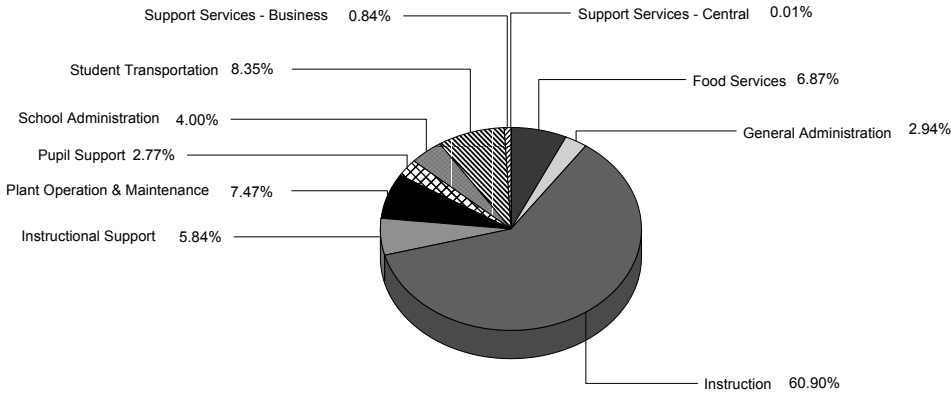
FINANCIAL INFORMATION
