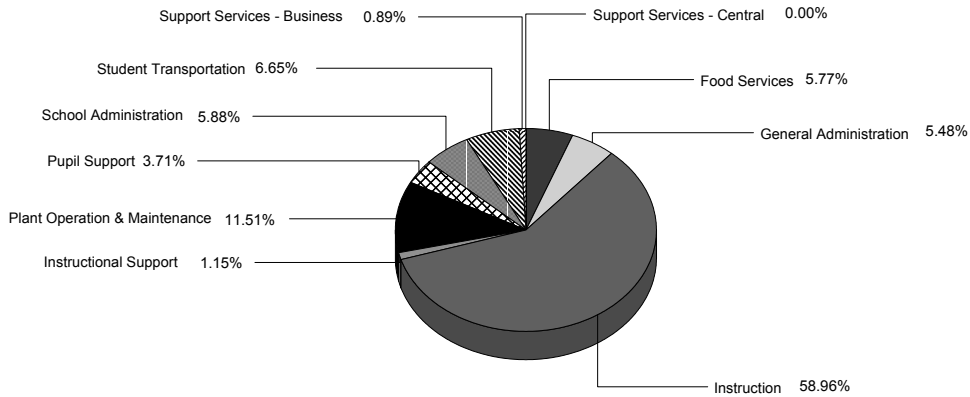
FINANCIAL INFORMATION
