Located at the heart of West Virginia, Grant County is a remote farming area that is still continuing to show some growth -- small but steady -- unlike the state. This county school system, however, is more alive than ever and making leaps and bounds in the area of achievement. For the second year in a row, the county was identified and acknowledged for being among the top 22 counties in the state in achievement through standardized testing assessment. Attendance is also high for the county and while all schools are fully accredited, one school has received exemplary credit status.

The pride felt by this school system is obvious and is communicated throughout the area in the passage of a 20 percent levy to support the system in educational endeavors.

"No child is to be left behind" will be the mission of this school system and all efforts will be made to ensure that our students are first and foremost in these efforts.

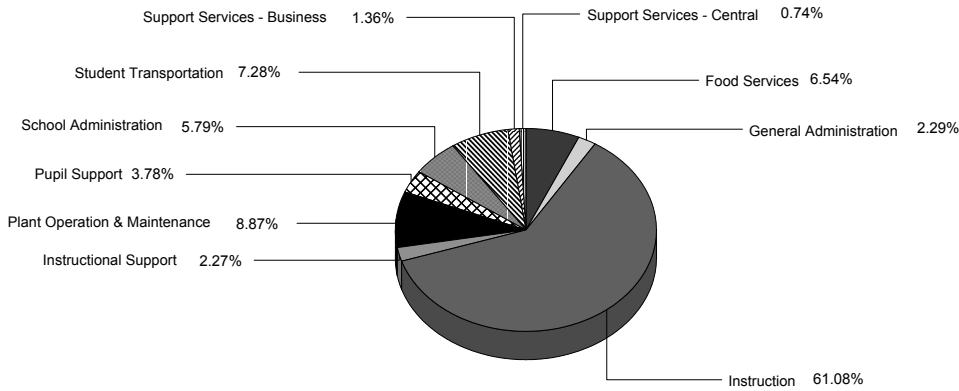
FINANCIAL INFORMATION
