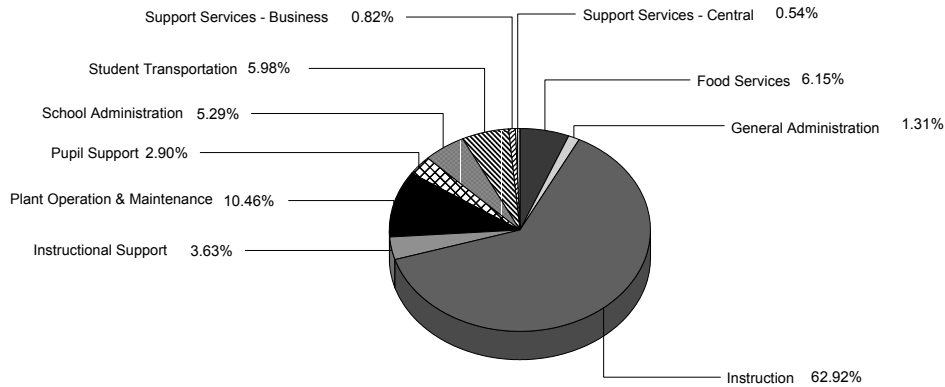
FINANCIAL INFORMATION
