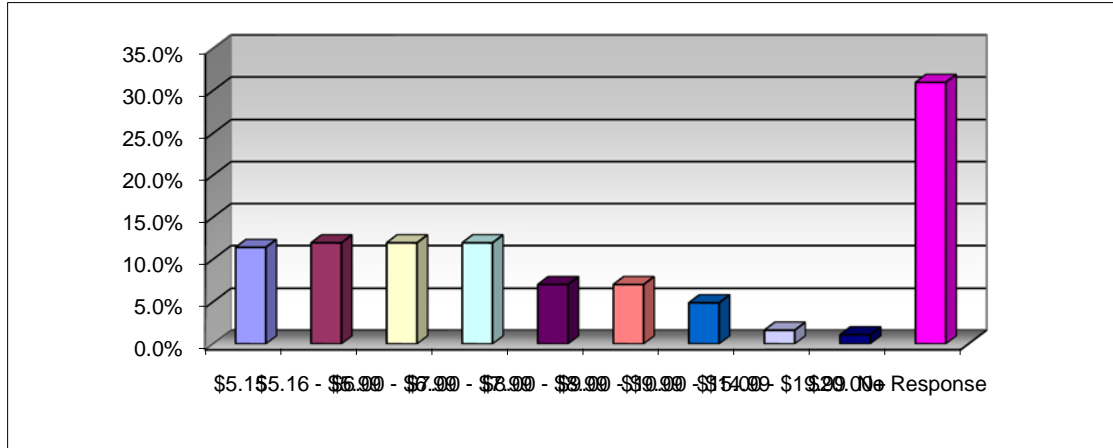

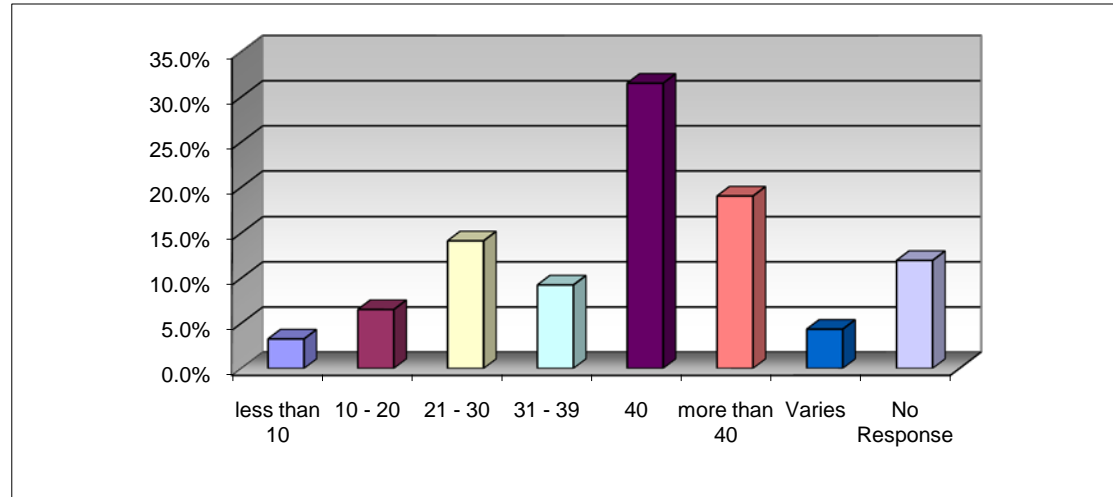

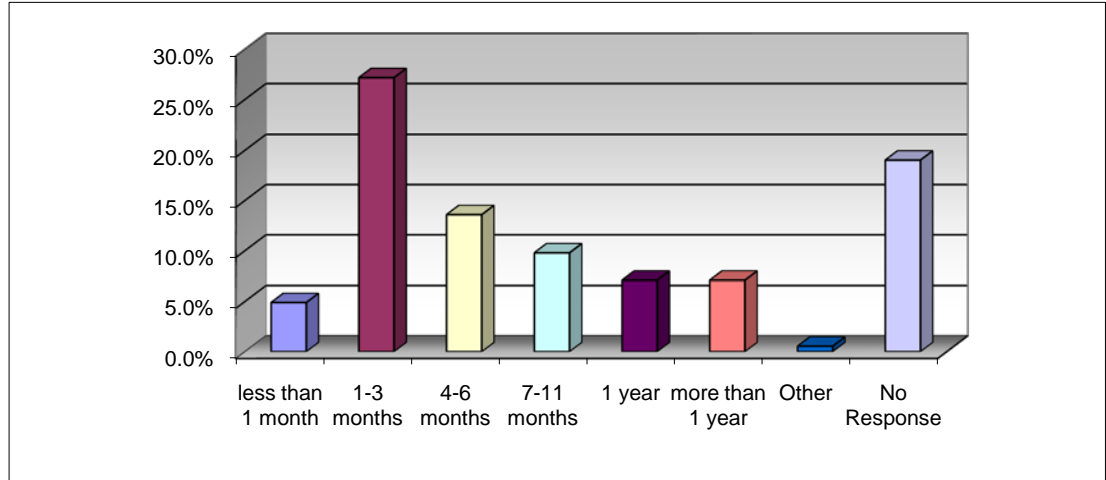

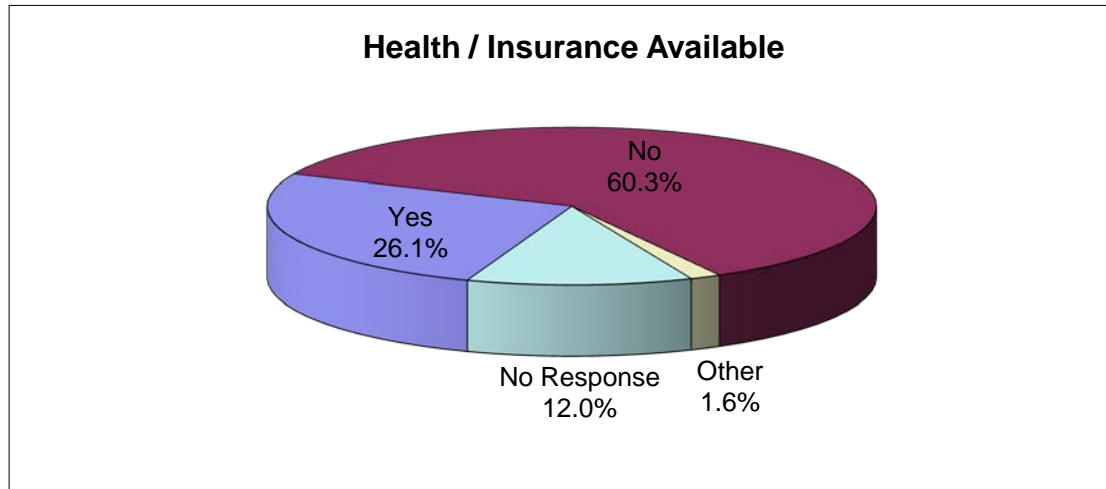

Health / Insurance Available Percentage Responses

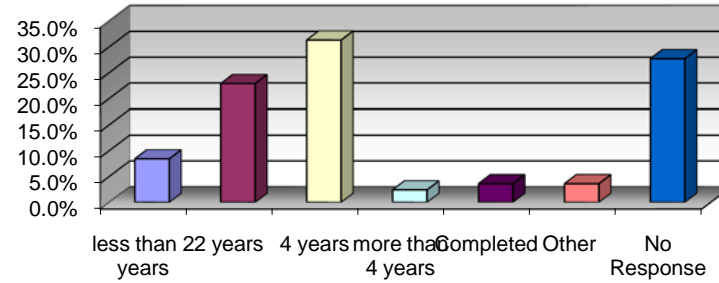

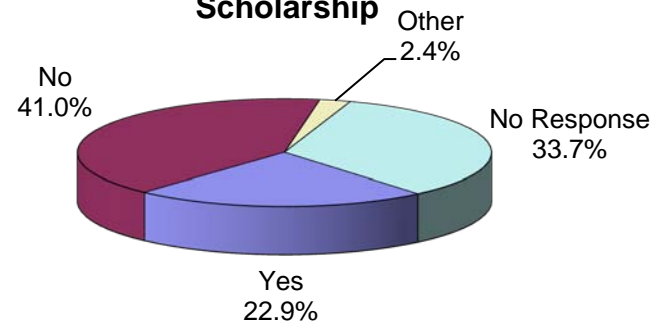
Length of Program

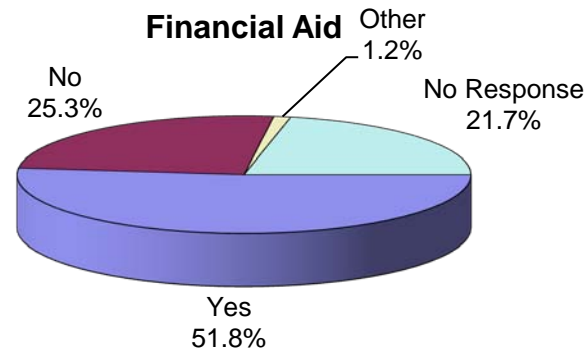

Financial Aid Percentage Responses

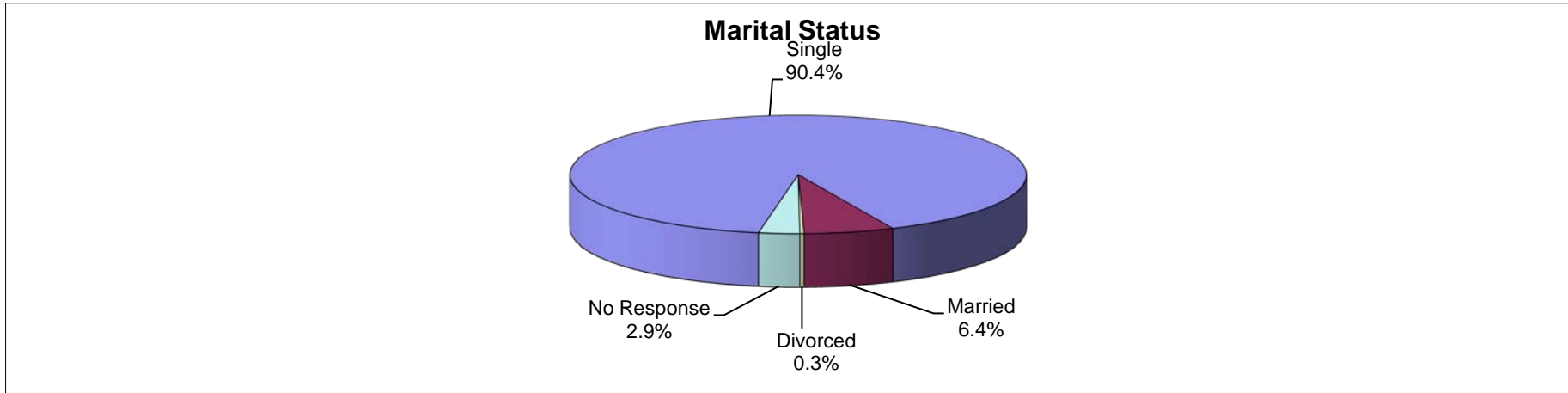

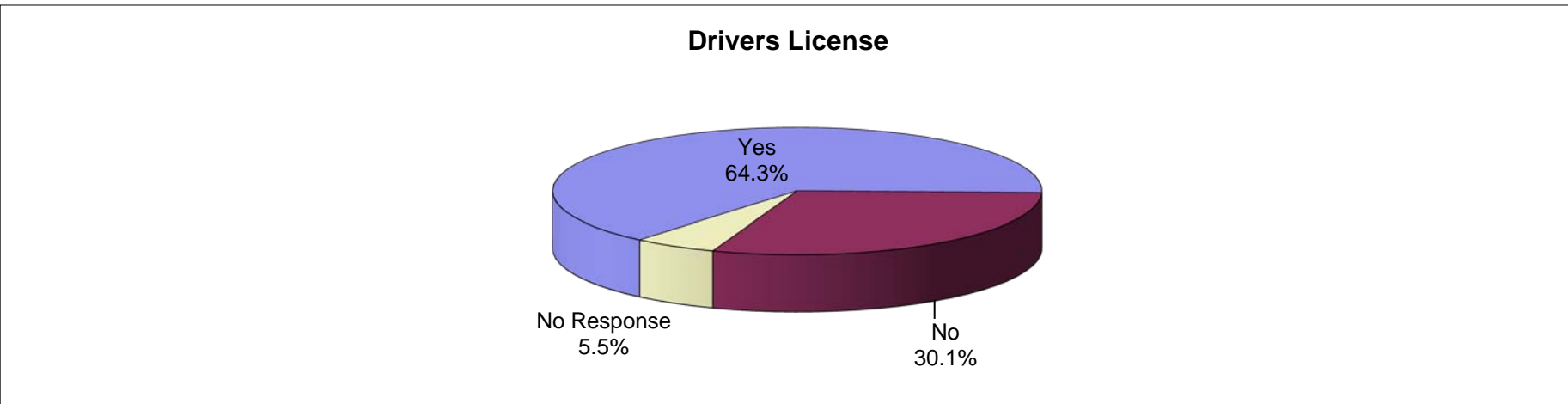

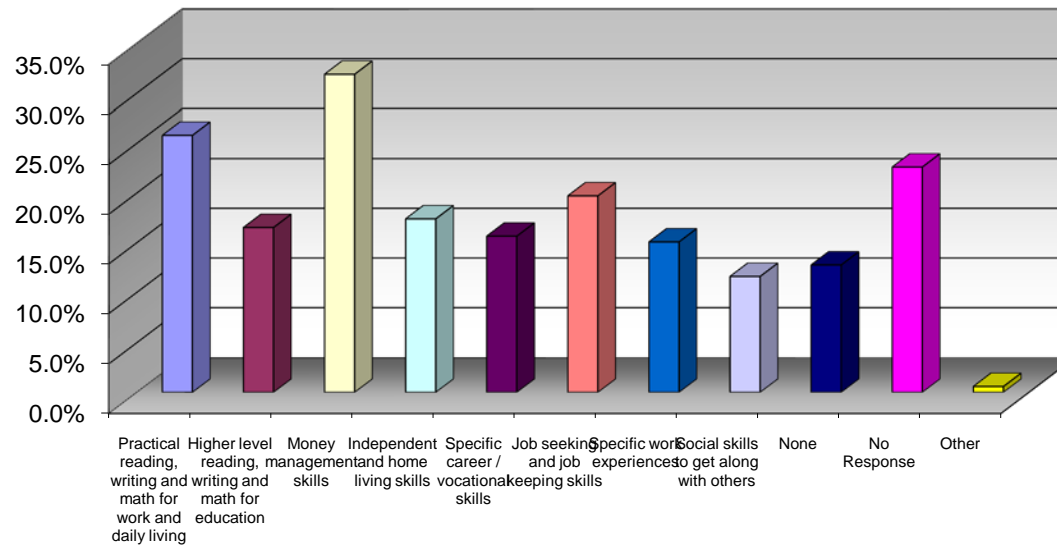

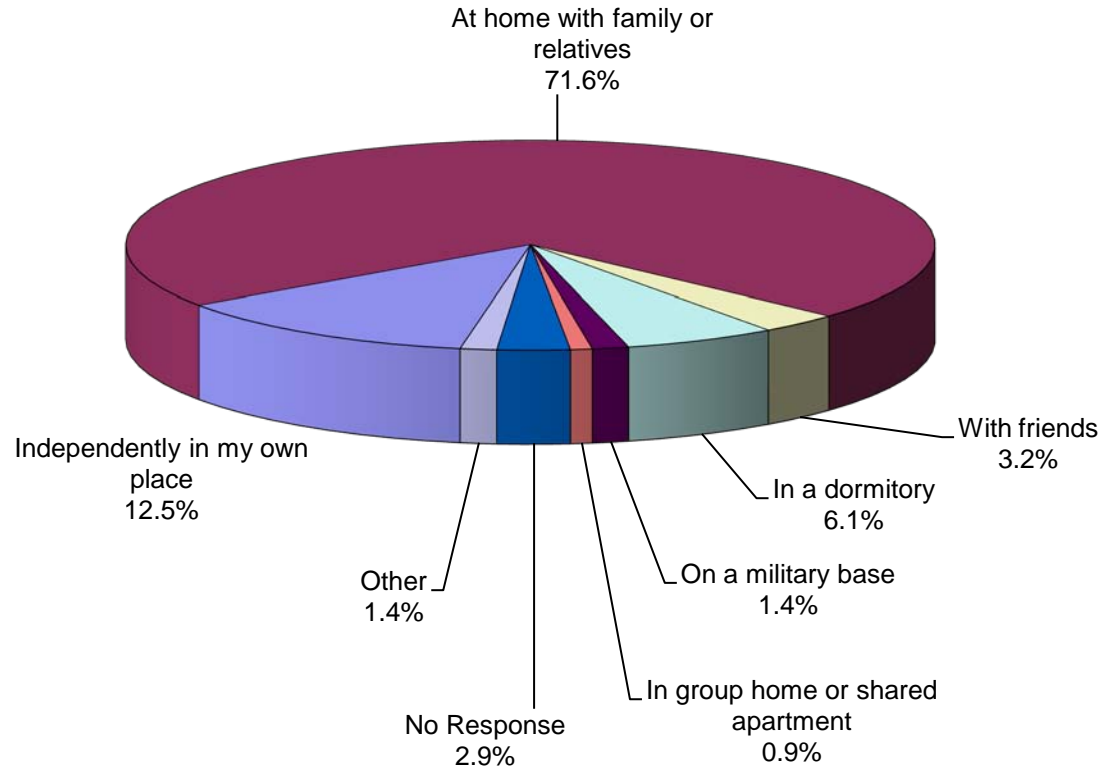

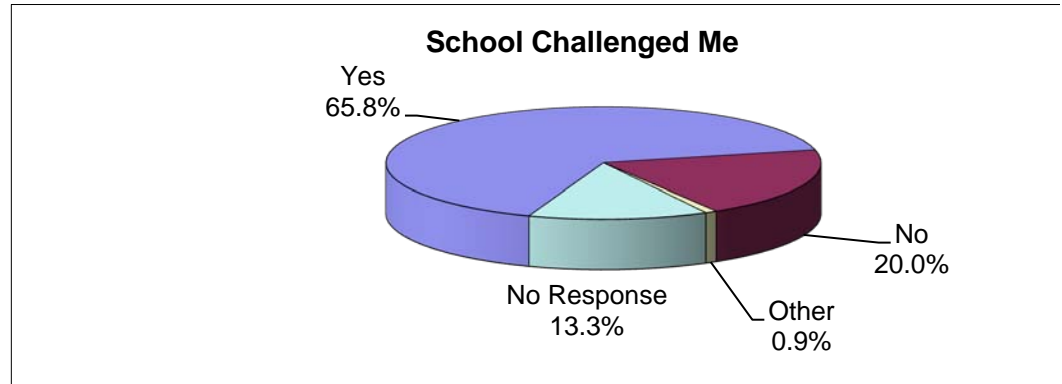

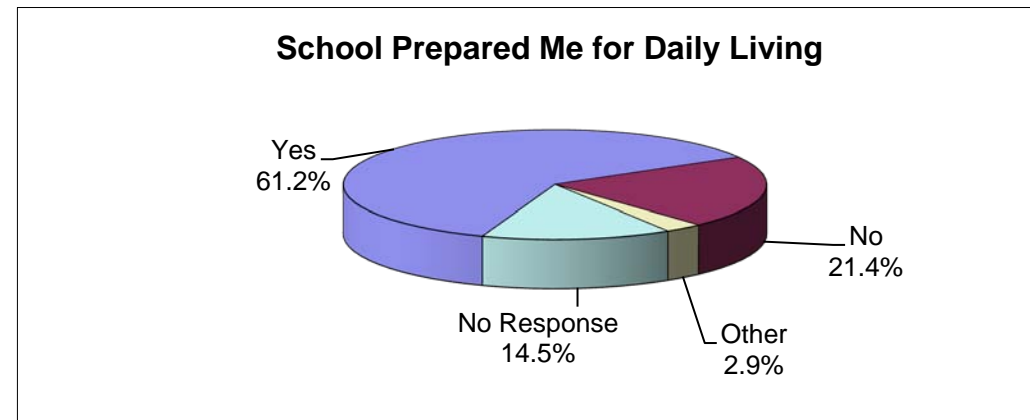
School Challenged Me

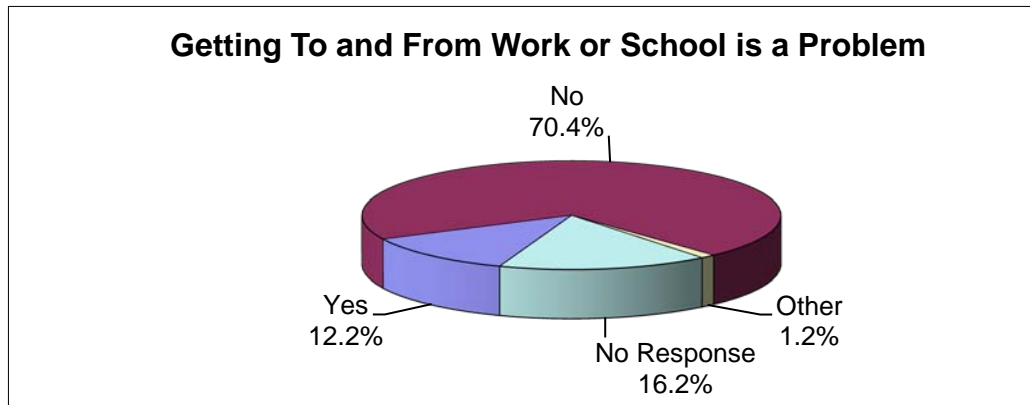
School prepared me for daily living
