DRIVER EDUCATION REGULATIONS: (POLICY 2422.2)

§126-22-1. General.

1.1. Scope. -- These rules establish the standards and guidelines for approved driver education programs in West Virginia.

1.2. Authority. -- W.Va. Const., Article XII, §2 and W.Va. Code §18-2-5 and §18-6-1, et seq.

1.3. Filing Date. -- November 15, 2002.

1.4. Effective Date. -- December 15, 2002.

1.5. Repeal of Former Rule. -- This legislative rule revises and supercedes all previous regulations governing driver education in West Virginia.

§126-22-2. Applicability.

2.1. West Virginia Code §18-6-1, et seq., authorized the West Virginia Board of Education, with the advice of the State Superintendent of Schools and the Superintendent of the Department of Public Safety, to promulgate rules governing the establishment, conduct and scope of driver education in public, private, parochial and denominational secondary schools of West Virginia subject to certain exceptions set forth in the West Virginia Code.

2.2. The following standards shall be applicable for all driver education courses offered and made available to persons within the state, regardless of whether the courses are offered by public, private, parochial, denominational or commercial schools.

§126-22-3. Standards for an Approved Course.

3.1. The driver education course shall be organized and designed in such a manner that it does not preclude the ability to provide a program equivalent to or surpassing the following requirements (exclusive of the time required to pass between classes).
