GUIDELINES FOR ARTICULATION AGREEMENTS BETWEEN
SECONDARY/ADULT SCHOOLS AND POSTSECONDARY COLLEGES (7124)

Section 1. General

- 1.1 Scope - This interpretative rule establishes the guidelines for an articulation agreement between vocational-technical centers and community colleges, community college components and two-year branch colleges in West Virginia.
- 1.2 Authority - West Virginia Code 18-2B-2
- 1.3 Filing Date - October 15, 1986
- 1.4 Effective Date - December 14, 1986
- 1.5 Repeal of Former Rule - This amendment incorporates the regulation for undergraduate credit for advanced salary.
