### WVSDB CEFP Facility Improvement Update:

In our ongoing commitment to providing a safe and modern campus environment for our students and staff. We wanted to update you on the continued campus-wide work from CEFP at The West Virginia Schools for the Deaf and Blind's campus.

Firstly, we've prioritized the safety of all by modernizing campus elevators, ensuring smooth and secure transportation for everyone. Additionally, Keller Hall is undergoing a revitalization with a fresh coat of paint, as well as new lights throughout the building, enhancing both aesthetics and functionality.

Originally known as the Potomac Academy, the structure later served as the classroom building for the School for the Blind. Following the devastating fire that engulfed the Administration Building, it now holds the distinction of being the oldest standing edifice on the campus grounds. Dating back to the late 1840s, this venerable establishment is now recognized as The Blue and Gold Building. The Blue and Gold Building renovation is progressing rapidly, with an anticipated completion by October 2024. This project promises to rejuvenate this vital space on our campus as it will be used as a new student center for our students to enjoy.

Further, the PE Building, which was originally completed in 1953 is set for comprehensive improvements including a new roof, door upgrades, window replacements, and installation of a state-of-the-art fire alarm and suppression system, enhancing safety measures. For Deaf and

Hard-of-Hearing students, the installation of a new fire alarm and suppression system in the PE Building ensures that they receive timely visual alerts in the event of an emergency. Similarly, upgraded exterior security cameras enhance campus safety, providing an additional layer of security for all students.

Our campus-wide projects encompass various enhancements, such as flooring replacement, tree removal, upgraded exterior security cameras, and the exciting addition of an outdoor classroom and greenhouse, along with a loading dock to facilitate operations. The addition of an outdoor classroom and greenhouse offers unique learning opportunities for both Visually Impaired and Deaf and Hard-of-Hearing students. These spaces provide hands-on experiences and promote sensory exploration, enriching their educational journey.

Overall, these upgrades demonstrate our commitment to creating an inclusive campus environment where all students can thrive. By addressing the specific needs of Visually Impaired and Deaf and Hard of Hearing students, we ensure that they have equal access to educational resources and opportunities, empowering them to reach the full potential of all who call our campus home.
